



Pontotoc County Fair Cosplay Contest

Costume Contest Categories:

- Children – Children under the age of 14 and Families
- Exhibition – Can be made or bought, not eligible for Craftsmanship awards.
- Craftsman – 50% or more must be made or altered.

Awards:

- Best in Show - Best Exhibition - Best Craftsman
- Kids- 1st, 2nd 3rd Awards
- Judge's Choice (Exhibition or Craftsmanship)- one for each judge

Contestants can register at Princess PineApples Booth.

Before the contest, the judges meet in a space reserved for prejudging, and the Craftsmanship competitors come in one by one and are judged.

Contestants should be in costume and be prepared to talk about construction.

Competition:

- Lineup will take place 30 minutes before the show.
- Kids Contest will be first, Exhibition, then Craftsmanship.

Costume Contest Rules:

- Contestants can only enter in one category. They can enter as an individual or as a group. Due to the unpredictable size of groups, a prize for each member cannot be guaranteed.
- No Sandbagging. If you have previously entered your cosplay into another competition and won a major award, you will not be eligible to compete.
- No skits during judging or catwalk.
- No nudity.
- No profanity allowed on stage. That includes messages on signs or clothes.
- No political or religious statement during the catwalk.
- No projectiles of any kind are allowed. Nothing must leave your person while you are on the catwalk.
- No flashpots, explosive devices, or similar special effects are to be used.
