 1. All winners agree to be photographed for the Pontotoc County Free Fair Book/Website and agree to share the winning recipes for publication there.
 2. All exhibits must be pickup up immediately following the awards presentation.
 3. The 4 Categories include: Cakes, Pies, Candy, and Cooks Choice (any dessert other than listed above).
 4. Desserts will be judged by overall appearance and taste. Judging will begin at 7:00 p.m. No entries will be taken after that time.
 5. Judging will be closed to the public.
 6. Contest open to Residents and Businesses in Pontotoc County.

To Enter How Sweet It Is.....

1. Select your secret weapon recipe and purchase your ingredients.
2. Prepare your dessert so it's at its height of perfection.
3. Complete the Entry form and bring it and your creation to the Pontotoc County Fair, Agri-Plex OSU Extension Kitchen, Friday, Aug. 26th, between 6:30 - 7:00 p.m.
4. Present your dessert in a disposable pan or plate with your name marked on the bottom (out of sight). Be mindful of dessert's presentation.
5. If your dessert must be kept cold, please bring it in a cooler to ensure temperature control.
