Contest: 7:00 pm in front of Outdoor Stage

Awards: First Place Trophy, 2nd & Third Ribbons & Participation Ribbons

Superintendent: First Class Pedal Pull, Ernest Chupp

Rules:

Nine Age Divisions - 4 year olds to 12 year olds, boys and girls

Contestants will pull in order of registration by each age division

All pull tractors will be furnished by First Class Pedal Pull

Only contestants, judges, fair volunteers allowed in the pull area.

Pedal Pull Tractors have weights on a skid and are timed to determine winner

Contestant pulling the longest distance wins

Must wear shoes, no pedaling barefoot is allowed

Judges or parents will not help start the pull/load

Contestants may pull as fast as he/she wants as long as they stay in bounds.

When the skid forward motion stops, the pull is done or ended

No jerking or pushing of the skid from the tractor will be allowed

If the contestant's foot slips off the pedal, the pull ends

In case of a full pull (tie) more weight is added and those contestants will pull again

No re-pulls allowed unless judges rule

First Place will receive a trophy,

2nd & 3rd place will receive placing ribbons

all other participants will receive participation ribbons.

Winners will be announced after each age division

Winners will qualify for the State Pedal Tractor Pull in Norman, Okla.
