Poultry Entry Form

All poultry exhibits must be pre-entered before 5 pm Friday, August 16, 2019. **NO LATE ENTRIES.** All poultry must have a negative Pullorum-typhoid blood test. No untested birds will be allowed in the Fair. NPIP producers need only provide copy of flock certificate. Blood testing will be available Wednesday, August 28, from 5:00 to 7:00 pm. Minimum age of birds for appropriate testing is 4 months. Barn will close as soon as testing is complete. All poultry will be exhibited as singles and must have been hatched after September 1, 2018. Exhibitors are limited to 2 birds per variety. Junior exhibitors (4-H & FFA) may exhibit in both open and junior shows. Only breeds/varieties listed in current APA/ABA standards will be eligible for awards. Exhibitors must provide feed, bedding and water containers for their birds, as well as daily care. See the Pontotoc County Fair Book for general rules and regulations and proper class names.
